One thing that could be of ENORMOUS benefit to our Bond Issue PAC is an unduplicated mailing list of students and former students over past 5 years whose residence (for tuition) is in Cooke County. This list could be cross-referenced against a list of registered voters and used for direct mail, phone calls, email blasts, etc.

Denise, is that doable? If possible, the records could also include home phone numbers and personal email addresses. This is considered "directory information" and is not restricted by FERPA.

If such a list can be generated, we probably need to have the chairman of the PAC draft a "public information request" for it.
